

# Is it safe to travel to the Middle East?

Both Israel and Jordan are modern states, but often the foreignness of them and our own personal comfort levels can erode our confidence to travel to these interesting places. Here's 6 reasons why its safe:

- 1. We can have a Skewed Perspective on Safety
  The news reports we receive and our distance from the actual events can distort our perspective of the day-to-day reality of the Middle East. While these places do see conflict, our experience is that it is much less than in other major cities, and are resolved very quickly.
- 2. We travel with local Tourism Professionals who know their Homelands and are trained to lead in safety
  SBT partners with reputable, local tour operators, guides, and drivers, who know their country and know where to go and where not to go for foreigners. During tours, they are constantly receiving updates on any potential situations.
- 3. Tour Companies have Safety as their Priority
  The local tour companies we work with, have your safety as their primary goal. Why? Not just because it's the right thing to do, but because if you were to get harmed on their watch, their good reputation would never recover.
- 4. Israel has Security as its Priority
  From the time you enter Israeli airspace to the time you leave, you'll see how committed Israel is to safety. Security on flights is far stricter than any domestic US flights. Israel takes tourists' safety very seriously since tourism is essential to its economy. Sadly, you will not feel the same sense of security today in London, Paris, or New York.
- 5. The Testimony of Others says it's Safe
  So many tourists are skeptical prior to going to Israel, but their
  feelings and perspective change as soon as they arrive. The
  Israeli Ministry of Tourism continually reports excellent ratings of
  tourist satisfaction, including Personal security. But don't just
  take our word for it. Instead, ask any anyone you know who has
  traveled there whether or not it felt safe.
- 6. We travel by the Grace of the LORD who is our Strength Oftentimes, God will challenge us to step outside of our comfort zone and enter into a seemingly risky scenario, so that He can show Himself to be our Rock and our Protector. On each of our tours, we trust our Safety to the LORD. If you pilgrimage to the Holy Lands, you will discover all this and more for yourself.

But for now, you can rest at ease. All the details of the biblical travel tour have been arranged so that you can focus on why you're there - To learn and grow spiritually, connecting the land to the Bible and both to your life.

# Experience the Lands of the Holy One...



Travelling through Israel and Jordan and experiencing the Lands of the Holy One with all of your five senses, you will feel the deep connection between the biblical story and the land where it played out. As you see the geography, visit archaeological sites, and feel the changing climate, your mind and heart will be quickened to understand the Bible in ways you had not imagined.

It is one thing to read of Herod's great engineering projects, it is another to see the ruins of Herod's Jerusalem temple or his seemingly impregnable fortress at Masada or his seaside villa at Caesarea Maritima. A trip to Mount Hermon and to Caesarea Philippi will help you understand why Jesus took his disciples there to ask who they thought he was. Hiking in the wilderness of En Gedi will reveal how David could hide from Saul and why he referred to God as his Rock. Experience the dry desert air and appreciate how the Dead Sea Scrolls were preserved at Qumran for over 2000 years. Visit Megiddo to understand why John used Armageddon as the final battle ground. Play detective over the two reputed sites where Jesus was crucified and buried.

0	19	Travel Day: Fly to Tel Aviv, Israel.
1	20	Tour Begins in Tel Aviv (Old Town Joppa): Meet at the airport; board the tour bus to Jaffa, site of two major Biblical events.
2	21	Through the Coastal Plains: Travel out to the south and visit the archaeological sites of Gezer (Gezer Calendar); Tel Marakesh Bell Caves; Tel Azekah; and Tel Lachish - two of the ancient gate cities guarding the capital Jerusalem.
3	22	Inland through the Jezreel Valley: Caesarea Maritima - Herod's ancient engineered port city; travel up through the Jezreel Valley; to Mt Carmel; and Meggido.
4	23	Around Nazareth where Jesus grew up: Nazareth city walk; Mary's Well; Church of the Annunciation; Nazareth Synagogue; the beautiful mosaics of Zippori; Cana where Jesus turned the water into wine; Franciscan Wedding Church.
5	24	Onto the Sea of Galilee: Nazareth Village - experience daily life in Jesus' time; hike up Mt Arbel for a stunning view of the Sea of Galilee; view of Mt Tabor, traditional Transfiguration site.
6	25	Following The Jesus Trail: Walk the Mount of Beatitudes (Sermon on the Mount); Tabgha; Church of St. Peter's Primacy; Church of the Multiplication; Capernaum; traditional boat ride on the Sea of Galilee; St. Peter's Fish Dinner.
7	26	Up to the Northern Tribe lands: Golan Heights; Gamla; Syrian border villages; view of Mt Hermon; Caesarea Philippi and Temple of Pan (Banias Springs); Tel Dan.
8	27	Crossing into Jordan: Sheikh Hussein Bridge border crossing; Bethany Beyond the Jordan (Baptismal site); Madaba - ancient Moabite city with the oldest mosaic map of the Holy Lands; Mt. Nebo, where Moses viewed the Promised Land and then died.
9	28	Tour Petra and the desert: Petra - the abandoned ancient stone city; Wadi Rum ("The Valley of the Moon") 4WD desert tour; ride a camel; overnight in Petra Desert.
10	29	Free Day in the seaside resort town of Eilat: Early morning return into Israel at Wadi Araba border crossing; remainder of the day is free to explore Eilat and on the Red Sea.
11	30	Into the Negev Desert: Start from the southern-most tip of Israel and journey northwards; Timnah Park and view a life-sized Tabernacle Replica; Mitzpe Ramon Crater; Tel Arad; Ein Avdat.
12	31	On the Dead Sea: Masaada- the last standing Jewish fortress; Lot's Wife salt formation; Ein Gedi - King David's desert refuge; float on the Dead Sea and bathe in natural mud.
13	APR 1	Ascent to Jerusalem: Qumran Caves and Dead Sea Scrolls; cross into the West Bank to visit Bethlehem; Shepard's Fields; the Nativity Church.
14	2	Around the Capital: Leave the West Bank to Jerusalem; Temple Mount; Western Wall; City of David & Hezekiah's Tunnel - a feat of ancient engineering; Davidson Center; Yad Vashem.
15	3	The Old City of Jerusalem: Mt of Olives; Mt Zion; Via Delarosa; Old City Markets; the Upper Room; Pool of Bethesda; Church of the Holy Sepulcher; Golgotha; the Garden Tomb; .
16	4	End of the Journey: Farewell at Tel Aviv airport; return flights.
